DATA NOTES:

- This year’s Top Ten lists recognize schools for high performance on the spring 2007 assessment for grades 3-8, 10 and 11 in communication arts and mathematics.
- Schools with fewer than 10 test-takers or less than 95 percent participation for the specific subject/grade assessment were not included in this report.
- Schools are grouped by size: 1) schools with fewer than 250 students, 2) schools with 250-500 students, and 3) schools with more than 500 students. Grade configuration may affect the size category in which a school is placed. For example, an elementary school or high school that includes the middle grades was placed in a size category based on the total K-8 or 7-12 enrollment.
- Because the middle grades may be included in an elementary school or high school, elementary schools and high schools appear in the junior high-middle school lists.
- Building enrollments are provided, as well as the percentage of the school’s students receiving free or reduced-price lunch and the percentage of minority students enrolled.
- At the end of the report are two lists that indicate how many times a particular school or district appears in the report.
